Arnold Bertram Steinbis, age 93, of Bad Axe passed away on Friday, February 15, 2019 at the Huron Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe.

Arnold was born in Port Hope on June 1, 1925, youngest of six children of the late Herman and Hedwig "Hattie" (Schultz) Steinbis. He married Carol Jean Perdue in August of 1961 in Port Hope. She preceded him in death in September 2004.

Arnold was a long time Huron County farmer who also worked for Tower Automotive. He retired from farming in 1976 and from Tower in 1989. He enjoyed hunting and fishing.
