



## Elizabeth "Betty" Ann Binder

Elizabeth Ann "Betty" Binder, age 100, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday morning, December 30, 2021 and was at home with her family at the time of her passing.

She was born on November 27, 1921 in Lincoln Township to Ray and Myrtle (Smith) Lane. She married Wilfred A. Binder on June 28, 1941 in Napoleon, Ohio. He preceded her in death on May 4, 1998.
