



## Genevieve "Genny" Peruski

September 28, 1932 - August 25, 2025

Genevieve "Genny" Peruski, age 92, of Minden City, passed away peacefully on Monday, August 25, 2025, surrounded by the love of her family.

Genevieve was born on September 28, 1932, in Kinde, the daughter of the late Joseph and Mary (Polega) Schramski.

On June 27, 1953, she married the love of her life, Eugene Peruski, at St. Mary Catholic Church in Kinde. They shared 64 wonderful years together before his passing on January 24, 2018.

Genny was a proud graduate of a country school in Kinde. In her early years, she worked in Detroit at Cunningham, Farm Crest Bakery, and Champion Spark Plug, before she and Eugene returned home to Minden City to start their family. Together they built a life centered on faith, family, and hard work, operating a farm that continues today as a third-generation family farm.

She was a devoted parishioner of St. Isidore Parish – St. Mary Catholic Church in Parisville, where she was also a member of the Rosary Sodality. Genny was active in the VFW Ladies Auxiliary #5740 and dedicated many years helping with the St. Mary's picnic. Known for her strong work ethic and vibrant spirit, she enjoyed bowling with the valley Thursday night ladies League, traveling with Eugene to Florida during the winters, and spending

time dancing—especially to the polka. She enjoyed being part of the Kinde Seniors club. She also loved baking, visiting the casino, playing euchre, tending to her lawn and flowers, and, above all, cherishing time with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, who were the light of her later years.

Genevieve is survived by her children, Glenn (Patty) Peruski and Carl (Charlene) Peruski, both of Minden City; her grandchildren, Ryan Peruski of Midland, Justin (Kayla) Peruski of Minden City, and Tyler Peruski of Minden City; step-grandchildren, Jessica of Owendale-Gagetown and Hank (Jessica) of Battle Creek; great-grandchildren, Brody, Ruby, Claire, Karlie, and Clarke; and step-great-grandchildren, Avery and Zoey.

She was preceded in death by her children, Dale and Rosemary, both of Minden City; her beloved husband, Eugene; and her siblings, Anna, Tony, Frank, John, Ben, Regena, Martha, Joe, and Marie.
