She valued her family above everything else. She was never shy to talk about her children and grandchildren. We sure hope she only shared good stories about us because the bad ones might still get us in trouble. She and Orin were married for 60 years, and she was the best wife and Mom in the world.

She would wake up before sunrise to have coffee with Orin, take the kids to school, work all day and pick them from their practices. She never missed one of their football games, wrestling matches, track meets or baseball games. We always knew she would be there when we looked up in the stands.

Goldie will always be loved and a hole will forever be in our hearts. If there was ever a person who we know will be in heaven, it will be her. We love you Mom.

Goldie graduated from Bad Axe High School and will always be a Bad Axe Hatchet fan. Oh, and let us not forget about her beloved Pittsburgh Steelers, Detroit Pistons and Detroit Tigers. She worked at American Discount and then at Karen and Katie's Hallmark until her retirement. Many people grew to know Goldie during her time at Hallmark.
