December 12, 1917 - April 8, 2015

Halcyon Anna Walker, age 97, formerly of Bad Axe, passed peacefully into eternity in Decatur, IL on April 8, 2015. She was born December 12, 1917 in Detroit, MI to the late Arthur and Marguerite Bush.

Halcyon loved to quilt, enjoyed flower gardening, and managed the Montgomery Ward store for few years in Bad Axe. Above all, she had an unwavering faith in God.

In 1936, Clare Walker and she were married and began their life together on a farm near Deckerville, MI. They lived in Sanilac County until he preceded her in death in August, 1979. Later that year, she moved to Bad Axe, MI and remained there until 2009 when she moved to Decatur, IL to be near family. Halcyon and Clare leave behind many memories to their children: Marguerite (Jesse) Hoots of Mechanicsburg, IL; Janet Webb of Hillsboro, WI; Gerald (Nancy) Walker of Rockwood, TN; and Ellen Kirt of Madison, WI. One daughter, Elaine Virgo, preceded her in death in November, 2000. Halcyon is also survived by 12 grandchildren, 22 great grandchildren, and 3 great-great grandchildren.
