July 11, 1958 - December 26, 2021

Kevin Scott DeBoer, age 63 of Bad Axe, passed away suddenly on December 26, 2021, and has met his Lord Jesus face to face. He was born on July 11, 1958 in Cadillac, Michigan, the son of Alfred and Doris (Bode) DeBoer. He married Tammy Seibert on July 12, 1980 in Livonia, Michigan.

Kevin graduated from Lawrence Technological University with a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering Technology. He worked as an automotive engineer for 25 years. Kevin and his family moved to Bad Axe in 1996. He was currently a Bus Driver for Thumb Area Transit. He served his community as a member of the Board of Review for the City of Bad Axe, served as a Scout Master for Troop 555, and served in many areas within his church.

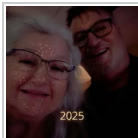

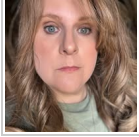

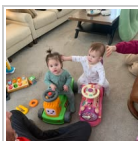
