



## Margaret Bouvrette

November 21, 1930 - September 1, 2023

Margaret Bouvrette, age 92, of Bad Axe passed away on Friday, September 1, 2023 at McLaren Bay Region Hospital in Bay City, surrounded by her three children.

She was born on November 21, 1930 in Bad Axe, daughter of the late Michael and Irene (Kalpin) Wolschlager. She married Floyd Bouvrette on November 13, 1948. He preceded her in death on March 11, 1994.

Margaret is best known by everyone as “Mrs. Walmart”, the friendly, red-headed door greeter that retired after twenty-five years of service on January 6, 2016.
