



## Margaret "Maggie" Sadro

June 4, 1960 - October 24, 2021

On Sunday, October 24, Margaret (Maggie) Lynn Sadro of Bad Axe, passed away after a courageous battle with liver cancer at the age of 61. She was able to be at peace in the comfort of her home, cozied up in her flannel pajamas and surrounded by family.
