



## Mildred Pease

March 17, 1931 - February 17, 2020

Mildred S. Pease, age 88, of Show Low, Arizona, formerly of Port Hope, passed away February 17th 2020, after a long battle with cancer.

She was born March 17, 1931 in Port Hope, Michigan to the late Harold F. Leese and Gertrude P. (Champagne) Leese.

She married Nelson H. (Hank) Pease December 10, 1949. Mildred was a 1949 graduate of Port Hope High School and obtained her real estate license in 1972, however her main priority was her family. 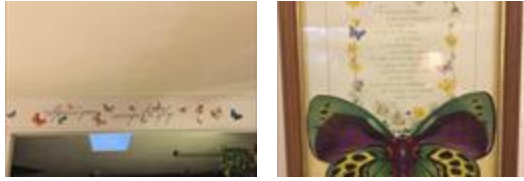

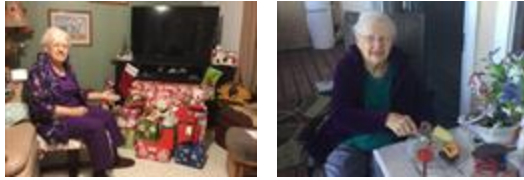
