Paul Daniel Coiner, age 87, long time resident of Bad Axe, entered His Father's Kingdom on Sunday, December 19, 2021 after a brief illness.

Paul was born in Protem, Missouri, December 25th, 1933, to Andrew and Bertha (Wolf) Coiner. Upon graduation from Forsyth High School, Forsyth, Mo, Paul enlisted in the U.S Air Force. He was a Korean War Veteran who upon return to the States came to be stationed at the Port Austin Air Base. While stationed there, he would meet and marry the love of his life, Gloria Perkins of Bad Axe. On November 3, 2021 they were blessed to celebrate their 65th wedding anniversary.

He was very active in the local church community, as well as serving upon several church mission building projects in Mexico. He served as a church board member and trustee for the Bad Axe Nazarene Church for many years.

Paul was very proud of his service to his country and wore his Korean war veteran's hat as a badge of honor every chance he got. His love and dedication to his country continued as he joined the Army Reserves after leaving active duty.

He was employed as a rural mail carrier for the Bad Axe Post Office until his retirement in 2001.
