Peter Flannery, age 89, of Bad Axe passed away on August 2, 2019 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe.

Peter was born on May 22, 1930 at home in Bad Axe, son of the late Guy and Emma (Peters) Flannery. He married Gloria Hanson on May 25, 1957 at Sacred Heart Church in Bad Axe. They were married 61 years when she passed away in October 2018.

Peter graduated from Bad Axe High School in 1948. Afterward, he served in the U.S. Army .He worked at Flannery and Son's dealership as Parts Manager until his retirement in 1992. After retiring, he and Gloria traveled extensively across the United States and internationally visiting 46 states and 18 countries. They wintered in Riverview, Florida from 1999-2015.
