Robert James Cregeur, age 99, of Bad Axe, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, August 18, 2021, surrounded by his family.

Bob was born May 12, 1922 in Fillion, MI, son of the late Cyril and Anne (McLaughlin) Cregeur. Bob had eight siblings. He married Helen Ann LaBelle January 4, 1947. She preceded him in death on July 1, 1981.
