Before coming to Bad Axe, Ted married Ruth Lovay and served in the army, living in El Paso, Texas. They came to Bad Axe in 1957 to work with his father Ray and brother, Paul. Ray had purchased Murphys Bakery in 1956 from Ted and Loeda Murphy. They owned the bakery for 50 years. Ted and Paul purchased the bakery from their father in 1957 and owned it until 2000 selling it to their sons Raymond and Paul. Ted bowled and fished when he had time after working a 60 hour week at the bakery. Ted spent many hours working to make and keep his business running smoothly. Ted founded the Thumb area Steelheaders with many new friends for 8 years. He wanted to improve fishing access and resources. In 1991, Ted got involved in the DDA. Improving the downtown area that he loved so much. Streussnig stressed that "team effort is the only way to get things accomplished." In 1972 Ted and Paul opened the bakery in Port Austin. Ted's wife Ruth ran the bakery in Port Austin and in 1985, they opened the sidewalk café and she also ran the café until 2000, which is when Ted retired. Ted found his new wife, Margie and married in 2005. Ted and Margie were married for 9 ½ years, traveling and visiting family and friends. All of Ted's grandchildren and great grandchildren were home this summer to visit and say their good byes. He will be missed by all that knew him.
