Virginia (Ginny) Avis Tageson, 77, of Bad Axe, passed away Monday, December 27, 2021 at Medilodge in Cass City.

She was born on October 18, 1944 in Bad Axe to the late Edward and Helen Haller. Ginny graduated from Bad Axe High School in 1962. Following graduation, she married her high school sweetheart, Thomas Dale Tageson, on October 27, 1962. They celebrated 43 years of marriage before Tom passed away in 2005.

Ginny loved reading books, so naturally, her first job was at the Bad Axe Library. Over the years, she became a janitor at the First Presbyterian Church of Bad Axe, where she was an active member. 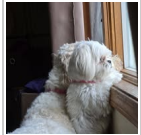
